Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Since the beginning of the month we have been working hard and trying to provide a different type of service which is noneucharistic. At PCC we did agree to trying this new service pattern for 6 months hoping that it would give people enough chance to 'taste and see'. However at PCC we reflected upon the very different views of those in the congregation. The PCC have therefore decided that we will be taking a poll of views and will be gathering on 12th February to do a simple vote as to whether we continue with the six month trial or simply return the 9.30 to its original Eucharist service. Please seek members of the PCC out and share your views. If we decide to return to the original service then that will happen in March.
