HOPE INTO ACTION

Members of our church have been involved for some time in the organisation which supports the homeless and refugees so they will be coming to speak to us about their ministry at the 9.30 & 11.15 services on Sunday July 7th.

Consultation on the new organisation of services

The new service schedule has been in operation for six months. The new schedule was implemented due to a significant staffing issues at our churches. We no longer have a curate. The clergy team is now made up of Marg and three retired ministers, with permission to minister in the churches. The team are not able to maintain the high workload that was maintained throughout the vacancy and indeed prior to the vacancy.

The position of Incumbent was for St. Nicholas Codsall and St. Peter's Codsall Wood and as Priest of both Marg expects to play a full and active part in both parishes, as was specified during her licensing by the Bishop.

The decision was taken to maintain three of the four services at St Nicholas. The

number of communion services to be celebrated has been reduced with care taken to ensure that communion is available at two of the three services offered on a Sunday.

Provision is made among the two parishes every Sunday in a number of services as well as Thursday Morning Communion.

Sunday does not reflect the full extent of ministry demands and the majority of Weddings, Funerals and Baptisms are now being undertaken by Marg.

Daily prayers are still in place. The PCC has been asked to vote in favour or against the new organisation of services continuing.

Craig Pickering is one of our Church Wardens. He plans to meet with members of our congregation after each of the three service today to gather the views of our congregation. Please feel free to discuss your feelings with Craig after the services. If you want to make a note of your views, paper is provided on the table in the Baptistry.
