

**Getting married at St. Nicholas' Church – Fees and Costs from  
1<sup>st</sup> January 2026**

Here is a list of charges to help you work out the cost of your wedding at St. Nicholas' Church:



1. The fees set annually for a Church of England wedding:

<b>Diocesan Fee for a wedding</b>	<b>£257</b>
<i>this helps pay for clergy</i>	

<b>PCC fee for Wedding Service, Certificate and Banns</b>	<b>£368</b>
<i>this includes the building, minister, administration etc.</i>	

2. **Utilities** **£108**

3. The charge for an Organist/Music Coordinator and verger (usually provided):

<b>Verger</b>	<i>oversees the church, prepares the registers etc</i>	<b>£52</b>
